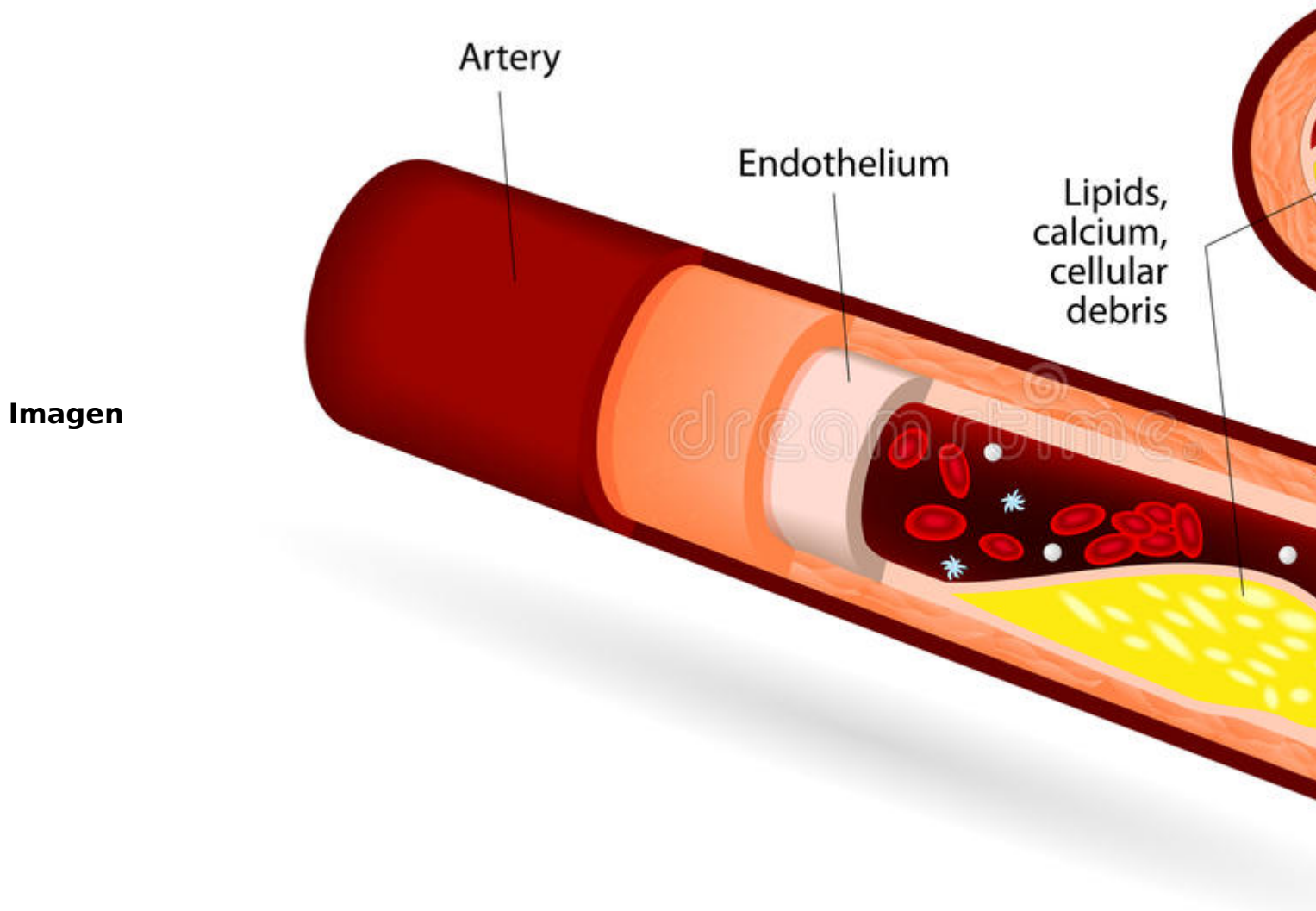

Contexto del término	<p>The concept that inflammation participates pivotally in the pathogenesis of atherosclerosis and its complications has gained considerable attention, but has not yet entered clinical practice. Experimental work has elucidated molecular and cellular pathways of inflammation in atherosclerosis. The recognition of atherosclerosis as an active process rather than a passive storage disease or a repository of calcium has highlighted some key inflammatory pathways. For example, mononuclear phagocytes contribute to all stages of this disease. The relationship between inflammation and atherosclerosis. From a clinical perspective, harnessing this knowledge may now help target therapeutics, change guidelines, and enter daily practice. Recent incontrovertible evidence have proven a causal role for low-density lipoprotein cholesterol in atherosclerosis, and we have highly effective tools for lowering LDL, consequently reducing cardiovascular risk.</p>
